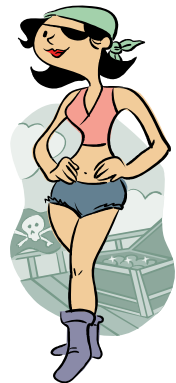

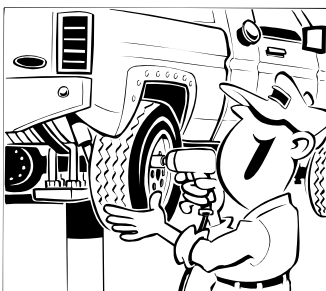

**NATIONAL MEETING CHECKLIST**

Have you remembered to:

	<b>Register?</b> Early bird registration closes February 15, 2010. Final date for registration is March 1 2010.
	<b>Order regalia?</b> Order forms are on the National Meeting web site. The final date for orders to be received has been extended to February 15.
	<b>Pack your driver's license, CAMS license and club membership card?</b> You will not be allowed to compete until these documents are sighted at registration.
	<b>Clean the car?</b> A dirty car will not win its class at the Concours.
	<b>Check your MG for safety and reliability?</b> Remember that the scrutineers can only stop you doing the Sprint or the Motorkhana if your car does not meet an appropriate level of preparation.
	<b>Organise your rocker cover racer entry?</b> As well as making your racing machine could you please contact Allan Semmler, asemmler@adam.com.au or 0418831027, to register your interest in this event.
	<b>Arrange pirate costumes?</b> Optional but it will be a lot of fun if we all enter into the spirit of the night.
	<b>Look at the motorkhana courses?</b> Maps of the 9 courses mentioned in the Supplementary Regulations have been placed on the National Meeting web site. Remember that only 3 of these 9 will be used.
	<b>Read the footwear requirements for Sprinting?</b> On page 6-12 of the 2010 CAMS Manual of Motorsport it is stated that "Shoes with leather uppers that cover the foot" is the minimum requirement. In other words most joggers/running shoes are not appropriate.
	<b>Tell us about dietary requirements?</b> We will do our best to meet them.
	<b>Check that your friends have registered?</b> It's nice to see some familiar faces from your MG centre. Give them the attached flier.
