



**2010 TIGHE CAMS MT COTTON HILLCLIMB SERIES

Dear Competitor

Firstly, thank you for your entry in this year's hillclimb series. This year we have made a number of changes to the class structure and the number of days over which hillclimbs will be run. Some of the questions that have been raised, along with the club's reply are set out below:

Are the Tighe Cams Series hillclimbs going to be run over two days? If so, then why the change?

The change was to allow all Series registered entrants to compete should the number of registered entrants be greater than the competitive run limit of 110 runs per day (110 entrants x 4 runs per day)..

How will the event be programmed over the two days?

Initially the event will be held over two days, irrespective of the numbers of entrants; however the club may elect to go back to a one day event, depending on numbers. However, if there are more than 110 entries per Round, then all entrants have the opportunity to run on Saturday pm and Sunday.

Will competitors have to compete on the two days to be eligible for trophies?

All runs on both days will count towards the Series points. It is the entrant's decision whether they run either or both days.

If it is dry on one day (Saturday) & wet the next day (Sunday), will both days of competition be counted towards trophies?

Yes

If a competitor doesn't run Saturday, does he or she get additional runs on the Sunday?

No.

Will there be security on Saturday Night if event is conducted over two days?

Yes.

Why has the series registration cost been increased by so much?

The cost has been increased to cover incidental fee increases for 2010, e.g. CAMS, tow truck, first-aid etc.

Why the change in entry procedure with the early entry price and then the higher entry price for later entries?

To ensure we had the opportunity to have enough time to organise the Series, rather than last year when were inundated with late registrations and a too short timeframe to vet the registration applications. The higher later registration fee rewards the people who were prompt in getting in their Series registrations.

Are there going to be 2nd & 3rd (as well as 1st) in class trophies awarded at the end of the series for each class?

Yes – end of Series only not per round.

Will there be allocated pits?

Yes.

Will the canteen be operating on both days?

Yes.

Some of the 2009 competitors have not registered in 2010 because they didn't understand what was happening & it was not clearly communicated to them prior to early close of registrations, and still hasn't been.

It is not the responsibility of the MGCCQ to ensure Series entrants read and understand the application correctly, but hopefully this note will have addressed many competitor concerns.
