SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

(To be read in conjunction with 2010 Hillclimb Standing Supp Regs and 2010 Tighe Cams Series Rules)

AUTHORITY. The MULTICLUB event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motorsport Ltd. (CAMS Ltd), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Regulations. Additional instructions may be issued subject to NCR 69. Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

THE COURSE will be the Mt. Cotton Hill Climb Course, 37 kilometres from Brisbane, Gramzow Road off Ring Route 45. The course is 946 metres long and bitumen sealed.

2. **ENTRIES** (a) **Entries** open 20th August 2010 for Tighe Cams Rd 4 and close Wednesday 15 September 2010. A \$20.00 fee will apply to dishonoured cheques.

(b) The Entry fee will be \$90.00 or \$80.00 if Series Registered Competitors.

(c) Personal Accident Insurance is included in the fee.

(d) Entries to be sent to - GPO BOX 1847, BRISBANE 4001.

(e) **The maximum number of entries may limited to 160 Competitors. This number may be composed of Series Registered Competitors and non-series registered competitors. Acceptance of entries will be given**

in the following order: - Series Registered Competitors' entries received first and then the remainder required to complete field will be taken in order of mail receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual

3. ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS. Persons eligible to compete are the competitors and drivers who are members of other CAMS affiliated clubs and the M.G. Car Club of Queensland Inc. (Points will be awarded to usual MG Car Club Perpetual Trophies).

4. STARTING TIME Official timed runs for Tighe Cams Rd 4 will commence at 12.00 noon Saturday 2nd October 2010 and 8.30 am on Sunday 3rd October 2010, unless other notified in Further Supp Regs. Running order as published.

5. SCRUTINY TIME AND PLACE (a) Scrutiny for all Tighe Cams Rd 4 competitors will take place at the course from 10.00 am. on the Saturday of the Event. Sunday Scrutiny is for those vehicles not scrutinized on Saturday and those that have left the circuit on Saturday. Selected vehicles may be re-scrutinized at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer and the Clerk of Course.

Scrutiny Schedule: It is preferred that vehicles be scrutineered in the same order as the Vehicle Running order as published on the MGCCQ website – www.mgccq.org after Thursday preceding the event.

Please complete paperwork at Administration building for scrutiny slip before entering scrutiny lanes. Entry to scrutiny area will be from the ring road with competitors formed up in two lanes on the water tank side from Gramzow Road towards the Hillclimb circuit.

(b) Extension of Scrutiny times is at the sole discretion of the Clerk of Course and Chief Scrutineer.

11. DRIVERS BRIEFING: Tighe Cams Rd 4 Drivers Briefing will be at 11.45 am. Saturday and 8.15 am Sunday of the competition at the Scrutineering shed or any changes will be advised by the Public Address system.

12. COMPETITION: Regularity Trials Point Score Rules:

(a) Attendance: Competitor must attend every day of each round

(b) Runs: The number of familiarization and scoring runs for each round shall be determined by an independent person namely Clerk of Course for the Round

(c) Scoring Procedure: A competitor shall lose one point for every whole two tenths of a second greater than the competitor's run target time and two points for every whole two tenths of a second less than the competitor's run target time (this is the current formula)

(d) Abandonment: If a regularity Class run is abandoned due to force majeure and not all class competitors have had their opportunity to run, then that run will be declared non –scoring

(e) DNS & DNF: A competitor who fails to start or finish a run shall be awarded a score for the run calculated by adding five points to the worst Regularity Class score for that run

(f) Target Time: A competitor shall nominate a target time for scoring runs in seconds to a maximum of two decimal places. The nominated time shall be advised personally by the competitor to the chief timekeeper, or deputy in his/her absence, at the timing shed prior to lining up for the run. If a competitor does not nominate a target time for subsequent scoring runs, the last advised target shall be considered to be the nominated target time

14. ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE:

MINIMUM LICENCES: Current CAMS Level 2S/J, or above, club membership and CAMS vehicle logbook must be presented at document check.

13. GENERAL:

a) Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

b) Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

Use of prohibited Substances

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

REFUND OF MONIES shall be conditional upon the following:-

Notification before 22nd September, 2010 by phone and then in writing – 100% Refund.

Notification before 28th September, 2010 by phone then in writing, full refund less \$20.00.

NO REFUND WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER 29th September, 2010.
