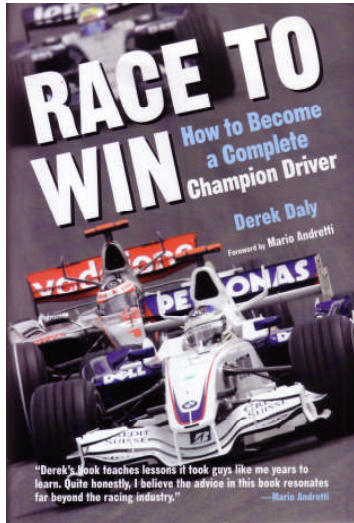


BOOK REVIEW

RACE TO WIN By Derek Daly

Derek Daly competed as a Professional Racecar Driver for seventeen years before becoming a Television Motor Sports personality and businessman. He won the British Formula 3 Championship in 1977 before progressing on to Formula One racing in a career that spanned 49 Grand Prix starts culminating in reaching 10th outright ranking in the World Championships of 1980. He also had six starts in the Indianapolis 500.

After his career in motor sport Derek opened the most advanced driver training/racing school in the United States in 1996. In 2002 he founded Motorvation a unique provider of counselling and learning solutions. Derek now travels the World speaking to corporations assisting them to build high performance teams.

This book is a combination of his experiences obtained within the motor industry and his association with some of the top drivers who ever participated in the sport.

Daly turned his attention to the mechanics of success. He has parlayed his experience and hard won understanding into a phenomenal career teaching the principles of high performance to audiences throughout the auto and business worlds. This book offers readers the benefit of Daly's insight and a rare inside look at world class auto racing. Drawing on his original research and first hand experience with some of the legends of the professional auto racing including Rusty Wallace, Roger Penske, Mario Andretti and A J Foyt, Daly discusses why some individuals and teams fail to reach their potential while others become successful and famous.

A complete course in winning. The book outlines the six key aspects of becoming a successful racecar driver. Daly points out the different strengths and weaknesses among different drivers and accordingly he emphasizes the importance of creating an environment that takes advantage of these differences.

As entertaining as it is instructive, his book will open a world of possibilities to budding and accomplished race drivers, motor sport fans and anyone who wants to know what it takes to win.

The principles outlined in this book can be applied not only to sport and business environments but also to one's own personal development.
